Call for Submissions to the Summer School for Doctoral Students

Submission Guidelines and Procedure

All proposals must be in English language and submitted electronically through the EARLI submission system: <u>https://www.earli-eapril.org/</u>. Please keep in mind that all participants need a valid EARLI account to submit a contribution. The submission system will be open from January 31st 2024 until March 31st 2024. Decision of acceptance will be send by April 30th 2024. Please note that places are limited for up to max. 25 doctoral students.

Each individual submission must have:

- A title of up to 100 characters (including spaces)
- An abstract of 100-250 words
- Description of the whole dissertation project (100-200 words)
- An extended summary of 500-1.000 words (including theoretical background, research questions and hypotheses, research design and method, significance for theory, policy, and practice, references)
- Three questions you would like to discuss at the Summer School
